Notes on Accommodations/Amenities:

- Demonstrations take place in a separate room off of dining room. There is a table at the front for demonstrations and chairs for the audience.
- Kitchen staff is extremely protective of the kitchen facility, and won't let you enter without hairnet, booties, etc, so do not depend on them to provide you with any supplies, assistance, or amenities.
- Demonstrations are scheduled before lunch, so some will meander in to get a sample. We have also gone around the lunch room and provided samples and a hard copy of the recipe to those interested.

- Kitchen staff is extremely helpful and are willing to provide equipment and other supplies, but we suggest that you arrive equipped with everything you will need.
