- H/H:** Half Hardy - Perennials - less hardy. Annuals - hardier.
- WS:** Winter Sow - A method of winter sowing in milk jugs.
- Light:/Dark:** Some seeds need light to germinate. Others need darkness.
- Alternating:** Some seeds respond well to an alternating temperature (55-60/night - 70-75/day) to germinate.
- Grow Cooler:** Many seedlings like to germinate in warm temperatures, and then grow on in cooler temperatures.
- Plastic:** Cover the container with plastic until germination.
