

I have a Smoke Tree that seems to be a bit unhealthy at the moment. I planted this tree about a year ago and it seemed very healthy in early Spring/Summer with seed shoots and new growth. However, by mid Summer we started seeing leaves curling. The tree has sprung two new shoots, but within a few weeks, the leaves on these shoots are also drying/curling.

The tree is given water by two lawn sprinklers, which water 6 days a week for 30 minutes per day.

Note: we increased the sprinklers in July from 3 days/week to 6 days. The tree was already showing signs of stress at that time.

I recently added drip to the tree, but the ground seem fairly moist, so I can remove it if needed.
